

Put on your dancing shoes for Swing Night with The Glenn Miller Orchestra, or try to out-do the other Parrotheads on Beach Night with Son of a Sailor (a tribute to Jimmy Buffett).

So mark your calendars and bring the whole family out for these great concerts. We hope to see you there!

Saturday, July 27: *The Glenn Miller Orchestra*

Glenn Miller first formed his big band in 1938 and it quickly became an enormous success with multiple hit records, including *Chattanooga Choo Choo*, *Moonlight Serenade*, and *In the Mood*. The band toured the world, playing for sold out shows and dominating the airwaves. Miller joined the army in 1942, but tragically disappeared over the English Channel on a flight from London to Paris in 1944. It wasn't until 1956 that the current Glenn Miller Orchestra was formed after the success of the film *The Glenn Miller Story*. Since then, the band has toured consistently, playing an average of 300 shows a year. The Glenn Miller Orchestra remains the most sought after Big Band in the world. With over 1,700 compositions in their repertoire, they're a favorite of both young and old. The band is led by Nick

Hilscher, who has two albums and is the former bandleader of the Tommy Dorsey Orchestra. Don't miss out on what is sure to be an incredible performance!

Saturday, August 3: *Son of a Sailor and Groove 101*

Larry Pearson, a self-proclaimed "Parrothead", has been touring for the last 10 years with his band, *Son of a Sailor*. This dedicated troupe of musicians performs the unique sound and style of Jimmy Buffett in a very authentic way. *Son of a Sailor* recreates the atmosphere of a genuine Jimmy Buffett concert, including costuming and audience participation. Bring your beach chair and Hawaiian shirt and enjoy all of your favorite Jimmy Buffett hits, including *Margaritaville*, *Cheeseburger in Paradise*, and, of course, *Son of a Sailor*.

Opening for *Son of a Sailor* is a local band, *Groove 101*. Made up of eight musicians, all local to the Ludington area, *Groove 101* brings extensive experience in both music performance and music education. The band was formed in the fall of 2012 as a byproduct of the West Shore Community College Jazz Band. The group features Craig Avery on keyboards, David Claire on drums, Jason "Harvey" Hargreaves on bass and vocals, Keith Kuczynski and Ted Malt on saxophone, Stephen Plummer on guitar, John Taranko on trumpet, and Erin Wall on vocals. All of the band members recently found themselves in the same place at the same time and discovered they had a ball playing together. The band plays '70s funk and progressive jazz as well as top 40 hits, and is sure to appeal to a range of musical tastes.
